Application for conversion of barns to form 2 dwellings (Barn C to become E and F) Mr and Mrs Evans, neighbours to the site, had stated concerns 4346 over the application, as the extension of barn C was so extensive that it almost constituted a new build. It was also felt that the size of the extension eliminated any parking which could have been facilitated on site. It was agreed that a letter be sent to Torridge expressing the 4347 Council's confusion with the plans and also recommending refusal due to gross over-development of the site. **Accounts and Audit** 4348 The accounts for 2014 were shown to the Council and were 4349 agreed.
