4506. MCTI Report

Cllr Worden reported that it was decided at the meeting that potholes that were considered dangerous or risky would be filled in. The maintenance of minor roads, including gutters and drains would be minimal, with councils able to do their own work with someone doing Chapter 8 Training to supervise works.

The cleaning out of ditches on a voluntary basis is fine.

4507. Village Green Issues

There is some dispute of who own VG99/VG47 on the Village Green. Cllr Worden has submitted the plans to the Torridge Solicitor who will determine the ownership. From that point Village Green land should be registered with Land Registry to avoid all further disputes.

Cllr Perkin had a map showing part of the Village Green was registered with Land Registry, copying to Cllr Worden. The right of way to the church room is not under dispute. Cllr Worden informed the meeting that the maintenance contract may need looking at if it is determined there is more of the green to look after.

4508. Wayleave on the Village Green

Western Power have been and mapped the poles on the Village Green and are arranging payments for those poles.

BT want to run a fibre optic cable to the Green and put a pole up. It was suggested the pole was to the corner and went around the green rather than straight across.
